The Mapungubwe Institute for Strategic Reflection (MISTRA), in partnership with the University of Johannesburg (UJ), is pleased to invite you to an occasional lecture by former Director General of the World Trade Organisation (WTO), Pascal Lamy. The lecture will take place on 23 October 2017 at the University of Johannesburg, under the theme 'Globalisation and the tragedy of the commons: Can the world attain shared prosperity?'

Lamy was ranked in the top 50 of the world's leading thinkers by the British magazine, Prospect, in 2014, and among the 100 most influential thinkers of the 'Thought leader Map 2015'. He is recognised as a key figure behind some of Europe's biggest political triumphs

during his tenure as the head of the cabinet to president of the European Commission, Jacques Delors. He is currently the President Emeritus of the Jacques Delors Institute and World Committee of Tourism Ethics, as well as board member of several institutes and foundations. He graduated from the Ecole des Hautes Etudes Commerciales (HEC) in Paris, the Institut d'Etudes Politiques (IEP) and the Ecole Nationale d' Administration (ENA).

Lamy has also written several publications for the European Union with a focus on the Union's vision of globalisation. Some of these include *The Geneva Consensus* (Cambridge University Press, 2013) and *Now for the Long Term* (Report of the Oxford Martin Commission for Future Generations, 2013).
