

YVES BERTONCINI

DIRECTOR OF NOTRE EUROPE – JACQUES DELORS INSTITUTE



Yves Bertoncini has been Director of the Jacques Delors Institute since April 2011.

He assists the President in his activities, directs the team and is responsible for managing its work programme. He also takes part in the Jacques Delors Institute's research activities, focusing in particular on questions of European politics and institutions, and on issues relating to democracy, citizenship and mobility.

Yves Bertoncini also works from Paris as adminstrator at the European Commission, where he has worked at the Directorates-General of "Education, Training, Youth" and "Regional Policy" between 1998 and 2001.

Previously, he also worked in the office of the French Prime Minister with responsibility for research on Europe at the *Centre d'Analyse Stratégique* (2006-09), and as adviser to the Secretary-General of European Affairs (2010-2011). He has also worked for the French Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs on the organization of the "National Dialogue for Europe" (1995-1997) and at the French embassy in Algiers (1992-93). He also worked on international affairs at the *Fédération Française des Sociétés d'Assurance* (2002-05).

He is a member of the Franco-German Youth Office (OFAJ) advisory board, the *Cycle des Hautes etudes européennes* Steering Committee and the Europanova Steering Committee. He participated in the Ernst Dräger Stiftung and the American Council on Germany's "Young Leaders Program".

He is also an experienced educator on European issues, with past and current teaching positions at the *Corps des Mines* (Mines ParisTech, 2007-Present), the Paris Institute of Political Studies (2001-11) and the *École Nationale d'Administration* (2007-09).

He is the author of numerous books, articles and policy papers on European issues. Many of them deal with political questions (division of powers, European Parliament, democracy), including "Europe: le temps des fils fondateurs" (Michalon, 2005), "What is the impact of EU interventions at the national level?" (Notre Europe, 2009) and "Politique européenne – Etats, pouvoirs et citoyens de l'UE" (Sciences - Po/Dalloz, 2010). Yves Bertoncini holds degrees from Sciences Po Grenoble and the College of Europe in Bruges. He has also studied at Sciences Po Paris and at the University of California in Berkeley. He was born on 30 March 1970 in Chambéry and is married with three children.
